

## Finance & Economic Development Committee City Council Budget Hearings Land Use & Planning April 10, 2024

- 1. Considering the evolving zoning laws that may restrict certain developments based on zoning classification, etc., share if this budget provides the necessary funding resources to best handle.
  - a. Specify if any focus on any environmental aspects.
- 2. Discuss current vacant positions.
  - a. Specify duration of the vacancy.
  - b. Specify timeframe for filling position.
  - c. Specify any impact to Overtime, Temp Agency, and or Consultants.
  - d. Justify the need for the position.
- 3. Discuss the planned use for <u>\$525K</u> in Consultants, up <u>\$26K</u> over the prior year's budget.
  - a. Specify vendor name, amount of contract, expiration date, length of contract, how long City has been doing business with the vendor, and scope of services.
  - b. Specify if any of the vendors are DBE's.
  - c. Specify if any one-year reoccurring contracts.
  - d. Specify if any funds budgeted to provide any type of assistance to the Neighborhood Planning Councils and Civic Associations.
  - e. Specify timeframe for implementing zoning code reform updates, as funding was budgeted in the prior year, and if any plans to encumber funds for FY24.
  - f. Specify timeframe for completion of ADA Self-assessment, as similar amount of funding was budgeted in the prior year, and if any plans to encumber funds for FY24.
- 4. Discuss the **§350K** budgeted for Demolition.

- 5. Discuss the planned use for \$\frac{\\$110K}{\}20 budgeted in the Temporary Salaries and Temporary Agencies account lines, up \( \sigma \)827K over the prior year's budget.
- 6. Share the amount of fees collected from permits accessed by your Department for the last 3 years, and projected for FY25.
  - a. Specify the number of permits that are for new development for last 2 years and correlating revenue.
  - b. Specify if there are any on-line portals and or apps possibly so that constituents can check the status of permits, etc.
- 7. Provide an update on capital funds available for each of the Neighborhood Planning Councils (per NPC, per capital budget).
  - a. Specify the last time NPC's were allocated any funding.
- 8. Given that the 2028 Comprehensive Plan has been amended several times, discuss any plans for implementation, and or the next steps.
- 9. Considering the number of Inspectors, share within your departmental organization chart if they are aligned by certain quadrants, sectors, and or districts, and if so, please provide on a chart.
  - a. Provide FY2025 proposed organizational chart with the total number of employees (i.e. permanent, temporary, contract, vacancies).
    - i. If there are multiple divisions, please ensure there are sub-org charts that enumerate all the above.
